

# Yokohama English Church

## By train

Traveling from NAF Atsugi to Yokohama English Church by train is actually much easier than it may seem. Don't be intimidated. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact us through the church Web site—[www.tagnet.org/YEC](http://www.tagnet.org/YEC).

Detailed instructions are below:

1. Walk straight out the Main Gate for about 15-20 minutes until the end of the street. There will be a Gorilla Pachinko (gambling) on the left corner of the street.
2. Turn left and walk about 2 minutes until you see a bus stop, taxi stop, mini mart, and train station on the right side of the road. It is directly across a store called Book Off.
3. Enter the train station by walking up the escalator. Put enough Yen in the machine to purchase a ticket that will take you four stops toward Yokohama to Mitsukyo Station.
4. Put your ticket in the gate machine, get it back, and walk down the stairs to the platform that leads to Yokohama—should be on the left side.
5. After you get on the train, wait until the fourth stop before getting off. The station name is Mitsukyo Station.
6. At Mitsukyo Station, walk up the stairs, put your ticket in the machine, take a left, walk past KFC (if it is still there), go up the stairs, exit the station, walk across the bridge that goes over the street, turn left before you go down the stairs, then go down the stairs, and go to the last bus stop where bus number 116 picks people up.
7. Once you get on the bus, put 210 Yen in the machine and tell the driver you are going to Kamenokoyama. Remember, though, you will still have to press the button to get off so listen carefully to the announcements.
8. There is only one sharp right turn on the route. It is just after the sharp right turn that you get off the bus. You will be standing right in front of Japanese church property. If you walk a little ways in the direction the bus is going, you will see an SDA conference sign on your left.
9. Walk up the hill that has the SDA conference sign until you see signs that will lead you to Yokohama English Church.
10. Welcome to our church!
