- Navy blue long pants (no pleats)
- White shirt – strait collar
- Black shoes
- Black belt
- Navy blue socks
- Navy blue honor sash
- Burgundy neckerchief with Adventurer logo
- Navy blue beret
- Navy blue ties

#### Girls 9yr and under

- Navy blue jumpers (with pleats)
- White blouse (peter pan collar)
- Black shoes & navy blue socks
- Navy blue honor sash
- Burgundy neckerchief with Adventurer logo
- Navy blue Beret
- Navy Blue Cross-ties

#### Eager Beavers

- Same as Adventurers – no sash required
- Green neckerchief – honor chips are placed on neckerchief

#### Boys/Girls 10yr and older

- Khaki long pants (no Pleats with white shirt, military type)
- Khaki shirt with white shirt, military type
- Yellow neckerchief
- Black shoes – Black socks (boys)
- Black shoes - White socks (girls)
